MATH COUNTS PREP

MATH LEARNING CENTER

The district's math curriculum department has planned a new comprehensive program designed for the diverse needs of 6-8 grade math students. Included in the program offerings are new state-of-the-art online individualized instruction components, teacher guided instruction and small group support sessions. Hands-on math tools will be used to strengthen and extend math knowledge. This new approach is intended to enhance math skills for students from basic mathematical concepts to Algebra and Geometry related concepts. Using this more individualized approach, all students will benefit including those needing additional support to those seeking enhanced academic challenges.

READING/LITERATURE

Basic skills are covered, such as how to write a successful answer to a comprehension question, dictionary skills and vocabulary building activities. High level thinking skills are emphasized. Readings will include a novel and various other forms of literature.

ACADEMIC SUCCESS STRATEGIES

Students will learn how to take tests, how to become organized and how to study. Students will identify their personal learning style and utilize the strategies to optimize learning.

CODE OF CONDUCT

All school policies are in effect during the summer school sessions. Violations as indicated in the Troy School District Code of Conduct will be enforced as follows:

Level I Violations

1st offense: Warning and contact with parents
2nd offense: Dropped from program with loss of tuition

Level II and Level III Violations

Students will be dropped from the program with loss of tuition

Students may refer to the Troy School District *Rights and Responsibilities-Code of Student Conduct* for a listing and description of Level I, II and III violations. This is available at District middle school offices. A summary of these violations may be obtained from your instructor or picked up at Niles Center.

DRESS CODE

Students may wear shorts, skirts, or dresses that fall below mid-thigh. They must be below the student's fingertips when their arms are at their sides. No halter-tops, bare midriffs, tank tops, or spaghetti strap tops may be worn by either boys or girls. See-through or open mesh tops are unacceptable when worn alone. Acceptable tops must have straps that are approximately three fingers wide. No clothing with inappropriate messages may be worn. This includes sexual references, profanity, alcohol, or drugs. No hats or head covering may be worn in school (prior to the start of school through the end of the school day), unless religiously mandated. Clothing should be of proper fit and not revealing. Baggy pants which display underwear are unacceptable. For safety reasons, shoes must be worn at all times. Students who wear inappropriate clothing will be asked to change or call their parents to bring them appropriate clothing. This is a Level I violation as outlined in the Troy School District's *Rights and Responsibilities-Code of Student Conduct* handbook.
