High School Credit and GED Preparation Classes

Frequently Asked Questions

How many credits do I need to graduate?

If it is less than two years since your class graduated, you will need 22.5 credits to graduate. If it is more than two years, you will need 21 credits.

Are the classes free?

Students aged 16-19 years old without a diploma or GED are eligible for free classes. Adults 20 years and older must pay a \$25.00 registration fee. Classes for current day-school students are tuition-based.

Can I earn work credit?

Yes. We have various credit options for work experience, homemaking experience, vocational training and also military experience for students registered in our high-school completion programs.

Do I need my transcript to register?

If you have a copy of your high-school transcript, please bring it with you to register. We will send for a transcript from your former high school when you register if you do not have one.

What do I need to register?

If you are 16-19, please bring proof of age (birth certificate, school records, driver's license) and immunization records. If you are 20+, please bring a driver's license.
