

Youth Services Summer Sensation FAQ's

Who can attend Summer Sensation?

Summer Sensation T.O.T.S. is available for children 3 - 5 years old.

Summer Sensation C.A.R.E. is available for children who have completed kindergarten through sixth grade.

When does registration take place?

Registration for current C.A.R.E. families begins mid-March. Troy families (not enrolled in the C.A.R.E. Company) may register beginning April 1st.

Online registration begins mid-March at www.troyceonline.com for current families and April 1 for open registration.

What do children do during the Summer Sensation program?

The summer is full of activities. Weekly activities are planned around a theme. Children will take part in arts and crafts, outdoor play, large and small group activities, gym, cooking, science experiments, field trips, and more!

Does my child have to come everyday or every week? Can I make changes to my child's schedule?

Schedules can be very flexible from week to week. You may register for one week or every week, depending upon your needs. There is a two day minimum during the selected weeks.

Schedules may be changed through mid-May. Additional days may be added at anytime, space permitting.

Will my child go on field trips? (School-age programs only)

A field trip is scheduled on Friday during most weeks. Transportation to and from the trips are in Troy School District buses. A field trip schedule is available to parents at www.troyceonline.com.

Field trips are to area attractions such as the Detroit Zoo, county fairs, Cranbrook Museum, miniature golf, bowling, water parks, etc.
